

The Ottawa Orchid Society is pleased to host the 2008 Canadian Orchid Congress Annual Meeting, and invites and welcomes you to attend the COC meeting and our 27th annual orchid show and sale on April 26 and 27, 2008. A special feature this year will be our orchid symposium, Orchids around the World, featuring eight excellent speakers. New for 2008 will be a class for cut flower corsages designed to adorn a dress loaned by the well-known couturier Richard Robinson. 1. Hotels:

The official hotel for the Ottawa Orchid Show is the Monterey Inn, located at 2259 Prince of Wales Drive. A special rate of \$99 per night plus taxes is available for bookings made before March 20. 2. Plant Hotel:

At the show, a room will be available for COC attendees to leave coats and plants.

3. Registration Costs:

- · The registration package has been set at \$80 for early registrants (before March 20) and \$96.00 after March 20. The registration package includes entry to the show, the symposium and the banquet, as well as access to the OOS lunch area.
- OOS volunteers and vendors may also purchase tickets for the banquet and the symposium. The banquet will cost \$40 per person before March 20 and \$50 per person after March 20 (including taxes and gratuities). A pass for all eight symposium presentations will cost \$20 before March 20 and \$30 after March 20. Individual symposium presentations will be open to the public for \$5 per lecture.
- · The Banquet will take place at the International Restaurant at Algonquin College, very close to the Show venue. A four course dinner will be offered. (Please advise us of any allergies or dietary restrictions when registering.) There will be a cash bar and an opportunity to view the auction items before the banquet. The Restaurant is a training school for future chefs and has won awards for the quality of service and food offered. Enjoy this very popular venue and the company of fellow orchidists, including our special speaker, Doug Kennedy of Orchids in Our Tropics and our fast-talking auctioneers Rick and Marilyn.

4. Registration Deadlines:

Delegates and guests are asked to register by March 20, 2008. The pre-registration deadline for plants and displays will be April 24, 2008, while

the registration deadline for the art gallery will be April 14, 2008.
